All participants should be at the state boat launch area no later than 12:45 p.m. You must have your registration number displayed on the starboard side of your boat. The parade will begin at precisely at

1:00 p.m., led by the pontoon boat "Boilermaker." Boats should form a single line behind the lead boat. The parade will proceed from the boat launch along the western shore, past Eden Beach, the dam, eventually turning toward south peninsula. It will continue along the western edge of the south peninsula, go around Bullard Point (the "cut"), continue along the eastern edge of the southern peninsula to the southern-most point, then head north along the eastern edge of the lake (Backshore Drive). The parade will terminate in front of the Boy Scout beach. Please do not break off of the parade route early. The objective is to maximize the number of camps on the lake that can view all of the parade participants.

Prize winners will be notified at the end of the parade to return to the judging area for photos and prizes. Awards will be presented for:

- Most Patriotic
- Most Original
- Most Spirited
