What is Eden 3E?

Eden 3E, LLC. Is a privately- owned solar group net metering project based in Eden, VT that distributes its Renewable Energy credits via Vermont Electric Cooperative (VEC). The solar project is rated to produce 220,000 kWh annually. Group net metering lets you benefit from locally produced renewable energy without the investment cost. There is no sign- up fee.

Who can become an Eden 3E member?

Anybody who is a VEC customer in good standing can become an Eden 3E member.

Why should I consider becoming an Eden 3E member?

Becoming an Eden 3E member will save you money on your electric bill, without the investment cost of installing your own solar panels. There is no sign- up fee, and no long- term commitment. You can cancel your participation at any time (effective the next month). There is no cancelation fee.

How does participation with Eden 3E work?

Based on your average annual electrical usage, Eden 3E will assign you a fixed percentage share in the monthly solar production. You will receive two bills every month; your regular VEC bill, and one from Eden 3E. VEC will apply your 'Net Meter Credit' monthly to your bill at their Renewable Energy rate of almost \$0.19/kWh. Eden 3E will bill you for your solar share at \$0.17/kWh, leaving you with a savings of almost \$0.02 for each kWh in your share. Average households carry roughly a 2% to 4.5% production share.

Please note: VEC bills you based on the electricity you use. Eden 3E bills you based on the amount of power the solar panels produce. This means that your solar credits/ bill will be lower over the winter and higher over the summer.

How do I become an Eden 3E member?

Sign up by contacting your local representative, Keren Ferrari. You will need to provide your name, address, phone number, average annual (or last years) electrical usage, and VEC account number.
