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SELECTBOARD MEETING MINUTES

November 25th @ 6pm

Present at the meeting Tim Bullard, Clayton Whittemore, Ricky Morin, Melissa Whitcomb, Molly Morin

1. Tim opened the meeting at 6:00pm.
2. Additions and Deletions to the Agenda: None
3. Citizens Input: None
4. Animal Control Update: A dog was taken to NCAL after it was abandoned at a house where it will be on a 10-day quarantine. The owner has been contacted but has not responded to the dog officer. He will have until the 10- days are up to respond before moving forward with surrendering him to NCAL to be rehomed.
5. Health Officer Update: None
6. Four (4) orders were signed. Tim signed the orders from last meeting.
7. Minutes: Tim motioned to approve the minutes for 10/28/25 meeting as written. Clayton seconded. Motion approved. Ricky motioned to approve the minutes for 11/11/25 meeting as written. Clayton seconded. Motion approved. Tim abstained from 11/11/25 vote as he was not at the last meeting.
8. Highway Dept. Update:
 - a. Cargill salt: Ricky motioned to sign the contract for Cargill Salt. Clayton seconded. Motion approved and contract was signed.
 - b. Other: Ricky showed a picture for snow being pushed out into the road as he just wanted to keep the selectboard informed. A letter was sent to a resident on Camp Road reminding him of the right of way and keeping it clear. Ricky has been looking into dash camera for the trucks. We will be opening BIDS for North Road paving grant for next summer on December 9th at the selectboard meeting. Ricky will follow up with Norm from Pike about Knowles Flat as he is supposed to be in contact with Jeff Walters from Eustis about getting the issue corrected.
9. Ratify Additions and Deletions: Ricky motioned to approve the personnel issues from 11/11/25. Clayton seconded motion approved with Tim abstaining as he was not present at the last meeting.
10. Grant Update/Discussion:
 - a. Sign Grant Reimbursements: The one for Griggs Road Reimbursement was signed. The reimbursement form for FEMA also needed to be signed.
11. Other
 - a. Generator Maintenance Agreements: We got two quotes for the generator maintenance that is needed for both the Town office and the school. One came from Brook Field and the other came from the Farm Yard Store. The selectboard

- has decided to have the Farm Yard Store do the maintenance for the town office generator and Brook Field do the maintenance for the school's generator.
- b. Fire Department Budget: The budget was looked at and will be discussed with the Fire Department on December 3rd at their meeting.
 - c. Sign Dog Ordinance: Ricky motioned to sign the dog ordinance as written. Clayton seconded. Motion approved.
 - d. Budget discussion: They looked at the budget to where we are now and do not see any big red flags. They would like to start working on the budget for the town report at December 9th meeting. When making the new budget they are going to ask the tax payers to spend extra to get the addition done for the town office. The selectboard will put it out for BID again come January 1st to get up dated estimates.
 - e. Town Report Conversation: Molly will go back further in older town reports to check to see who it's been dedicated to in the past before making that decision. The selectboard will work together on writing up the selectboard report. There will be some changes in the town report this year.
12. FYI: Tim went to the Sheriff's Department meeting to hear what is happening with that. The budget is still in the process so we have not gotten the new budget yet for them.
13. Adjourn. Ricky motioned to adjourn at 8:13pm. Clayton seconded the motion, adjourned.
