

Eden Youth Sports Committee Meeting 1/28/26 @4:30pm

1. OPEN MEETING: Meeting opened at 4:40
2. BASKETBALL CHECK-IN- Shirts for the 1st & 2nd grade team are ready for their game. The kids will keep them afterward.
3. GAME CANCELLATION- Game cancellation will be at the discretion of the coaches.
4. END OF YEAR AWARDS NIGHT- Kristina has ordered the 6th graders' plaques. The awards night for 1st and 2nd graders will be 2/17, the 3rd and 4th graders will be 2/18, and the 5th and 6th grade girls and boys will be 2/21. Molly will send a reminder for parents to return jerseys. Kristina will get napkins and plates for the awards nights. Trevor will look into pizza pricing; Molly will get a head count.
5. REVIEW FINANCIALS- The committee has spent \$2820.00 on legal fees (not including what has come out of the town fund). We are not expecting that to be an ongoing expense. 7. FUNDRAISERS- Looking for days in March, possibly February, as previously mentioned, depending on school availability (basketball still happens through February). Bingo, Dance, Bottle drive.
8. BASEBALL & SOFTBALL DISCUSSION- We need to confirm uniforms. The snow will have to melt a little before we can get in there. Sign-ups will provide more information on sizes and quantities. The wooden benches will be removed.
9. BASEBALL & SOFTBALL SIGN-UPS- We have enough for at least a tee ball team. Molly has gotten stack sports site to work. There will be a coupon code for people who want to avoid the added fee. Sign-ups will be dropped off at the school by Dan.
10. GYM COMPLAINTS- Discussion on picking up the Gym, which these members feel has been done. We are looking for more specific information regarding what hasn't been getting done.

11. CHILDREN OUT IN LOBBY- Molly has made a sign, and it will be hung out for the next game. No children can be in the lobby unsupervised, and ABSOLUTELY NO BASKETBALLS are to be bounced out there.
12. OTHER- Kristina will circle back to the email previously sent to Dylan and Chris about space in the Shed for EYSC stuff. Dan mentioned a cornhole tournament might be a good idea as well. Check in on date availability. Molly has revised the player code of conduct paperwork and is creating a picture release form. If jerseys are not returned, a bill will be sent to parents.
